Then you follow the link to your Representative's website with their contact info. I just contacted my Representative and it took less than 10 minutes to personalize and send a message!

This bipartisan bill is identical to an earlier bill (HR 2274), which was introduced in the 113th Congress and UNANIMOUSLY voted out of the House Financial Services Committee, 57-0, and ultimately passed UNANIMOUSLY by the full House, 422-0. We hope for a similar result with HR 686.
